The main focus of this journal is to enhance the knowledge of the readers, researchers and pediatricians on the current and upcoming development happening in medical domain of childhood & developmental disorders by providing the quality information, which can be used to mitigate the developmental disorders related to childhood. IPCDD impact factor for the year 2021 is 1.16. All published articles of this journal are included in the indexing and abstracting coverage of Index Copernicus, Google Scholar, Global Impact Factor (GIF), Publons, China National Knowledge Infrastructure (CNKI), Directory of Research Journal Indexing (DRJI), RefSeek, Geneva Foundation for Medical Education and Research, WorldCat, EBSCO A-Z, Studies receiving funding from a funding organization that is included on the list of PMC and Research Funder Policies or authors having NIH grant were submitted to PubMed.

During the calendar year of 2020, IPCDD received a total of 26 manuscripts, out of which 7 articles were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2020 around 10 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer
