Anxiety Disorders, Stress & Depression Treatment Market value \$17.4 Billion by 2022. According to a report, the world anxiety disorders and depression treatment market can demonstrate a mediocre CAGR of two.75% throughout the forecast amount from 2017 to 2022. In 2015, the world anxiety disorders and depression treatment market stood at £22.5 billion in 2015 and is projected to achieve £18.2 billion by a pair of 2020. According to World Health Organization, presently UK is calculable 300 million people globally are affected with depression, anxiety and stress. 


